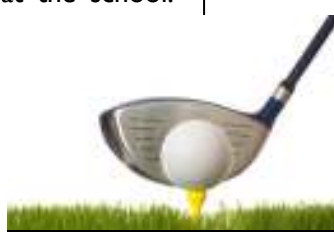

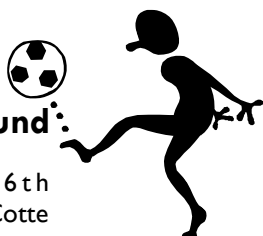


time has been made possible by these fantastic fundraisers. Their efforts have made such a difference to the learning and social opportunities of children at the school.
