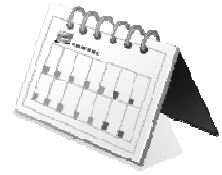
## Training Day Friday

## Harvest Gifts

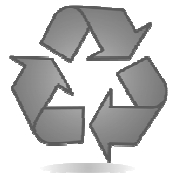

## Recycle for Art

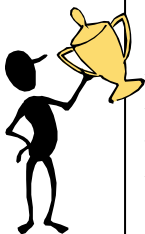
