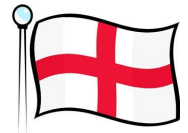

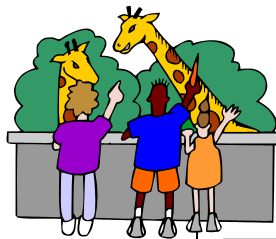

Each of the displays will be signed for the deaf and there will be special meet and greet sessions for lesser abled visitors to enjoy getting closer to the animals and their keepers.
